Kamal Singh's passing is an irreparable loss to the Global Compact Family and he will be deeply missed by all of us.



A man of humble beginnings, he made indelible imprints on the sands of time through sheer grit and perseverance. His distinguished career as a management professional and a sustainability advocate is testament to his tenacious spirit. He started his career at the All India Management Association (AIMA). He spent nearly three decades at AIMA, scaling up the ladder and being instrumental in launching many initiatives that brought laurels to AIMA in building its profile and equity with its stakeholders. He then moved on to the National HRD Network (NHRDN) and was its Director-General for more than four years, before joining Global Compact Network India (GCNI) as the Executive Director.

A seasoned management professional, a high-performing connector manager, a zealous HR practitioner, a torchbearer of CSR interventions and a passionate advocate of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) framework, he worked tirelessly to popularize their adoption. In spite of his professional commitments and allure of the corporate world, he always remained rooted in his culture, native customs and valued his relationship with people from varied backgrounds and contexts. He was always a genial host and forged enduring relationships through earnest gestures of goodwill. He was a great team-player, an efficient problem-solver with an inherent ability to approach complex situations with ease and a highly creative motivator; a unique skillset which was admired by all and sundry.

UNGC Anti-Corruption Collective Action Working Group Meet
Scaling up Anti-Corruption Collective Action within Global Compact Local Networks

UNGC, under ‘Scaling up Anti-Corruption Collective Action within Global Compact Local Networks’ project, conducted the October Anti-Corruption Collective Action (ACCA) Working Group meeting on 7th October 2020 wherein Working Group members from Global Compact Local Networks from across the globe were present and shared their inputs for the finalization and launch of the ACCA Playbook, along with the next steps of the Working Group. The Working Group has met through five consultations since April 2020 to develop the Playbook, which will enable Local Networks and their participants to make a clear diagnosis of the corruption landscape in their respective countries, including a situation analysis, the laws, policies, courts, challenges and opportunities, identifying relevant actors and experts and exploring appropriate ACCA and other multi-stakeholder efforts to fight corruption. Ms. Shabnam Siddiqui, Director, Dr. Somnath Singh, Project Lead and Mr. Arya Dev, Programme Analyst, Global Compact Network India had participated in this 6th working group meeting and shared inputs for finalizing and launch of ACCA Playbook.

Climate Smart Cities Assessment Framework 2.0



Post the launch of “Climate Smart Cities Assessment Framework (CSCAF), the Climate Centre for Cities at National Institute of Urban Affairs (NIUA), with technical support from its knowledge partners, supported a total of 143 cities in mapping their climate journey by collaborating with 25 city level and state line departments, supported by more than 20 partner organizations. With the deadline extended to 13th November 2020, almost mid-way into the process, participating cities have shown immense commitment and filled in more than 50% of the 108 data inputs for 28 indicators over the five thematic areas.
